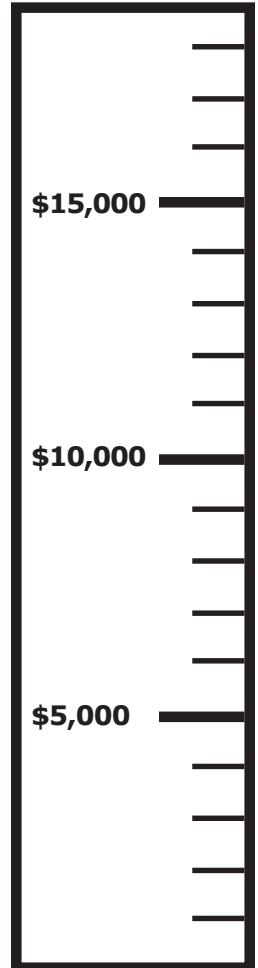

## Reminders for the Competitions:

### 1. Where to Buy 2006 National Tour Programmes:

They are available at Tom Lee Music (Vancouver and Richmond), Jean Lyons School of Music (228-1555 West 7<sup>th</sup> Ave), and at the reception of the Competition. They are \$15 each.

### 2. What to Bring:

- a) Proof of age identification for First Elimination.
- b) **2 copies** of your music for First Elimination rounds, and **3 copies** of your music for Provincial Final rounds.
  - One copy **must** be an original - you are permitted to photocopy other copies of music for educational purposes.
  - Competitors must write down the **bar numbers** at the beginning of each line.
  - Sharing sets of music is **not** allowed.

### 3. For Competition Days:

- \*\* **You MUST check-in with the reception desk at least 15 minutes before your scheduled class.** \*\*
- Late competitors may not be given the opportunity to perform.
- When you check in, please hand over copies of your music to the volunteers, and use the washroom if necessary.
- **NOTE:** There are no practice rooms at the venues.

### 4. During the Competitions:

- a) Repeats are permitted within the maximum time limit.
- b) Candidates must respect the specified time limit.
- c) Candidates must perform all registered works, but you are permitted to change the order of their programme.
- d) **Audio/Video recordings:** a parent may make recordings only of his or her own child.
- e) Any device that makes noise or light must be **turned off** at all times: **no phones, pagers, digital watch beeps or cameras.**
- f) CMC volunteers and Board of Directors will be there during the Competition, so please do not hesitate to approach them with questions or comments.

### 5. Results:

- a) Adjudicators' comments and marks will be given to the candidate after each elimination. Where possible, candidates will have an opportunity to meet the adjudicators.
- b) To proceed from the First Elimination to the Provincial Final, a candidate must receive an average of **80%** from two adjudicators. To proceed from the Provincial Final to the National Final, a candidate must receive an average of **85%** from three adjudicators.

### CANCELLATIONS:

Candidates who want to cancel **must** notify CMCBC **as soon as possible** or directly contact the CMC National Office.
